No-Waste Hay Feeder

The Slow Down Hay Feeder/Soaker simulates natural-grazing practices to cut down on hay waste and promote horse health. "Horses eat more slowly, because they have to pull hay up and through holes in a plate that covers hay in the feeder," say *The Trail Rider* contributors Kent and Charlene Krone. Made from durable, noncorrosive polyethylene plastic, the feeder holds about 10 to 12 two-pound flakes of hay. It doubles as a hay soaker; a plug in the bottom of the tub allows for easy water drainage.
